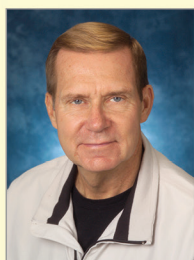


## FOLLOW DEWEY FROM A LIFE OF POVERTY TO CREATIVE GENIUS.
